1. Introduction

2. All visitors

- Ensure your own safety; beware of uneven ground there are holes and hollows concealed by the vegetation.
- Please respect the wildflower meadow.
- Please respect the wildlife and resist the temptation to scare them by chasing or shouting.
- Please do not feed the wildlife.
- Do not pick any wildflowers or other plants.
- Consider other park users, when walking, jogging or running on tracks and paths.
- Ensure young children are supervised at all times.
- Smoking is not allowed in the Park. Please dispose of lit cigarettes carefully before entering.
- Do not start fires or light barbeques in any areas of the park.
- No cycling.
- Sorry no dogs except for guide and assistance dogs we do not want to disturb the local fauna.
- Please don't climb trees or swing on branches.
- There are no litter bins, please take all litter home.

3. Groups

If you are leading a group, then please also observe the following.

- If you are meeting a guide, then please assemble outside the Community Library/Park Entrance.
- Leaders are responsible for their group at all times, ensuring appropriate language and behaviour for a public venue
