Nature investigation, learning and art and craft session

90 minute session for KS2 classes

Sessions available



Tree detectives: Using the ID sheets available can you identify the trees in the park? Are they deciduous or evergreen? How do the plants reproduce? Can we find different seeds in the park that show different ways of dispersal?

We will use *happa zome* technique or paints to make our own prints from plants and seeds in the park.

Session available all year.



Bug safari: Using the nature park's equipment we will go for a bug hunt in the meadow and woods. Using a classification key, can you identify the minibeasts? We will find out why the meadow is such a special place and how biodiversity is affected by humans.

Each student will take home a willow and tissue paper mini beast.

Sessions best delivered in summer term.

Food chains: Follow the quiz trail in the nature park to find out all about food chains. What food chains are in the nature park? Can you find a predator and a prey? Make a food chain craft to take home.

Session available all year.



- All sessions are led by an experienced environmental educator.

- Sessions are linked to the curriculum and can be adapted to fit your current scheme of work.
- Risk assessments are available.
- Sessions are 90 minutes long and you are welcome to stay in the park for lunch and enjoy free time.
